Dense, rich, ripe and expressive, offering a feast of plum and black currant flavors, with ripe pear, honey and floral overtones as the minerally finish wells up with intensity and harmony. Shows tremendous presence and depth. Best from 2017 through 2025. 348 cases made.—*H.S.*

- BERGSTRÖM Pinot Noir Ribbon Ridge Le Pré Du Col Vineyard 2013 \$60

Supple, seductive and distinctive for its pure blueberry fruit, shaded with white pepper, pear skin and floral character that dances merrily into the long and deftly balanced finish. Offers presence and intensity without extra weight. Drink now through 2023. 1,500 cases made.—*H.S.*

- **SEGHESIO** Zinfandel Dry Creek Valley Cortina 2013 \$40

This captures such a distinct sense of place it almost smells like Dry Creek Valley, with briary raspberry and smoky cinnamon aromas leading to complex, layered flavors of dried sage, licorice and dark cherry. Tannins sneak in on the finish. Drink now through 2024. 3,174 cases made.—*T.F.*

Plum, blood orange, black olive, toast and mineral notes mingle in this tight, bright red. Juicy acidity keeps this lively, while firm tannins keep it focused. Graceful, with good intensity. Drink now through 2025, 3,000 cases made.—T.M.

Toasty oak, ripe fruit and vibrant acidity add up to a balanced, expressive red. The cherry and berry flavors are bright and crunchy, while cocoa and mineral notes add depth. Lithe and lively. Drink now through 2021. 5,500 cases made.—*T.M.*



KIRKLAND SIGNATURE Signature Series Columbia Valley 2013 • \$17

Smooth and round, with expressive blueberry, pepper and floral flavors on a polished frame, generous and persistent on the finish. Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Syrah, Petit Verdot and Cabernet Franc. Drink now through 2022. 6,100 cases made.—*H.S.*



ROEDERER ESTATE Brut Anderson Valley NV • \$24

Sleek and charming, with yeasty apple torte and floral cherry aromas and rich, crisp flavors of lemon curd, spicy vanilla and fresh ginger. Drink now. 80,000 cases made.—*T.F.*



BODEGAS ALTÚN Rioja Crianza 2011 • \$20

Plum and pomegranate flavors are framed by espresso, licorice and loamy notes in this firm red, which has firm tannins and balsamic acidity, giving way to a bitter chocolate finish. Offers savory character, with solid structure. Drink now through 2025. 9,200 cases made.—*T.M.*



ATTEMS Pinot Grigio Venezia-Giulia 2014 • \$20

Bright and fruit-forward, offering lively peach and passion fruit notes underscored by rich, stone-tinged minerality, with a floral finish. A balanced Pinot Grigio that's creamy in texture and would pair well with lobster or other shellfish. Drink now through 2020. 9,000 cases imported.—A.N.



CELLERS BARONIA DEL MONTSANT Garnatxa-Carinyena Montsant

Cims del Montsant 2012 • \$15

Black cherry and dark chocolate flavors mingle with notes of smoke, licorice and mountain herb in this focused red. Lively acidity keeps this fresh, while well-integrated tannins impart structure. Drink now through 2020. 6,491 cases made.—T.M.

CAVES ALIANCA Dão 2012 • \$11

Firm and juicy, with refined flavors of red currant, plum and forest floor that are imbued with a lively minerality. The spicy finish features notes of graphite. Drink now through 2019. 20,000 cases made.—*K.M.*



DR. HEIDEMANNS-BERGWEILER Riesling QbA Mosel 2014 • \$11

This fleshy white offers concentrated aromas and flavors of baked apple, pear tart and lemon curd. The creamy finish is long and rich, with notes of glazed apricot. Drink now through 2018. 4,500 cases made.—*K.M.*



HEINZ EIFEL Riesling QbA Rheinhessen Shine 2014 • \$10

A juicy white, full of lush flavors of Gala apple, melon and tangerine. Spicy midpalate, with honeyed notes lingering on the citrusy finish. Drink now through 2018. 15,000 cases made.—*K.M.*



CASTLE ROCK Sauvignon Blanc Mendocino County 2014 • \$10

Melon, pear and floral honeysuckle accents add some charm to the juicy green apple and lemon flavors at the core. A note of lemon verbena emerges on the finish. Drink now. 17,665 cases made.—M.W.

A supple, well-spiced red, showing lively flavors of red berry, plum and cherry tart that are accented by notes of chocolate and cardamom, with a juicy finish. Drink now. 40,000 cases made.—*K.M.*



SCHMITT SÖHNE Riesling QbA Rheinhessen Crisp & Fruity 2014 • \$9

Rich raspberry jam flavors flood this white along with some smoky notes. Tangerine and spice accents fill the juicy finish. Drink now through 2018. 300,000 cases made.—*K.M.*
